Annual Report : 2025–2026

It is a matter of immense pride and gratification that DAV Public School, Bhatgaon successfully completed another glorious academic session 2025–26, reaffirming its commitment to academic excellence, value-based education and holistic development.

Brief Profile of the Institution

Established in 1997 under a joint agreement between DAV College Managing Committee and South Eastern Coalfields Limited, the school has grown from a modest beginning of 150 students in six rooms to a full-fledged Senior Secondary institution.

At present, classes from LKG to XII (Science & Commerce streams) are functioning smoothly with approximately **1,574 students** across **42 sections**. The school functions under the guidance of DAV College Managing Committee, New Delhi, while day-to-day administration is managed by the Local Managing Committee. The school is affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi.

The current academic session commenced on **1st April 2025** and will conclude on **31st March 2026**.

Academic Excellence

The academic year 2024–25 Board results once again brought laurels to the institution.

Class X (CBSE Board Examination 2025)

- **98.92% Result** achieved.
- **24 students** secured **90% and above**.
- **Master Abu owais and Master Anurag jaiswal** secured the **1st Rank with 98.6% marks**.
- **13 students** obtained **100 marks in Sanskrit**.

- **03 students** obtained **100 marks in Mathematics**.

Class XII (CBSE Board Examination 2025)

- **100% Result** with majority in First Division.
- **2 students** secured **90% and above**.
- Miss **Shikha Agrawal** topped Commerce stream with **96.2%**.
- Miss Priyadeep scored **100 marks in Accounts**.

Several students qualified in prestigious competitive examinations including JEE (Main), NEET, and various state-level entrance tests.

The school remains committed to maintaining high academic standards through periodic assessments, remedial classes, mentoring sessions and performance analysis.

Value Education & Moral Development

In alignment with the DAV philosophy, daily **Hawan and Community Prayer** are conducted to inculcate spiritual and moral values. Observance of National Festivals, community service activities, Swachhata Abhiyan, First-Aid training and awareness programmes are regularly organized.

Eminent personalities and spiritual guides from Arya Samaj and Brahma Kumaris, Ambikapur, were invited to conduct motivational and ethical orientation sessions for students.

Curricular & Co-Curricular Activities

Students are grouped into four Houses:

- **Shanti House**
- **Shakti House**
- **Sewa House**
- **Smriti House**

Inter-House competitions in literary, cultural and sports activities were conducted throughout the year. Activities included Debate, Quiz, Essay Writing, Poetry Recitation, Science Exhibition, GK Test, Art & Craft, and Mathematics Olympiad.

Students actively participated in:

- National Talent Search Examination (NTSE)
- National Science Olympiad

- English Proficiency Test
- State-level Vigyan Paheli Competition

Meritorious students received certificates and medals at district and state levels.

Sports & Games Achievements

The school emphasizes physical fitness and sportsmanship.

Under the aegies of **DAV NATIONAL SPORTS equivalent to SGFI** conducted by the **DAV CMC, NEW DELHI (session 2025-26)**:

- **Seven students** of Volleyball Team won Bronze medal.
- **One student** won Bronze medal in Athletics- Long Jump.
- **One Girl student** won Bronze medal in Javelin Throw.

Regular training in Athletics, Football, Cricket, Kho-Kho, Kabaddi and Yoga is provided.

Cultural Activities

Cultural development forms an integral part of DAV education. Weekly Inter-House cultural competitions were organized.

Students secured positions in:

- State Level Patriotic Song Competition
- Hindi Debate Competition
- Quiz & Rangoli Competition
- Group Dance and Drama Presentation

Annual Day was celebrated with grandeur showcasing students' talents in music, dance and theatre.

Parent–Teacher Partnership

The school maintains strong liaison with parents through:

- Academic Feedback & Remedial Planning Sessions

Constructive dialogue between teachers and parents ensures holistic development of students.

Professional Development of Teachers

The school presently has **54 qualified and trained teachers** dedicated to imparting quality education.

During session 2025–26:

- Teachers attended **Capacity Building Programme on ‘LIFE SKILL/BASIC’** organized by CBSE.
- Subject-wise Orientation Programmes were conducted by DAV CMC.
- Workshops on NEP 2020 implementation, Experiential Learning, and ICT Integration were organized.

Continuous professional training ensures effective teaching-learning practices.

Infrastructure & Facilities

- **34 Digital Classrooms** equipped with smart boards.
- **Two well-equipped Computer Labs** with 46 systems and high-speed internet connectivity.
- Separate Science Laboratories for Physics, Chemistry and Biology.
- CCTV Surveillance with **80 cameras** ensuring safety and security.
- Library enriched with latest reference books, journals and digital resources.

Special remedial classes are conducted for slow learners, while advanced learners are guided for competitive examinations.
